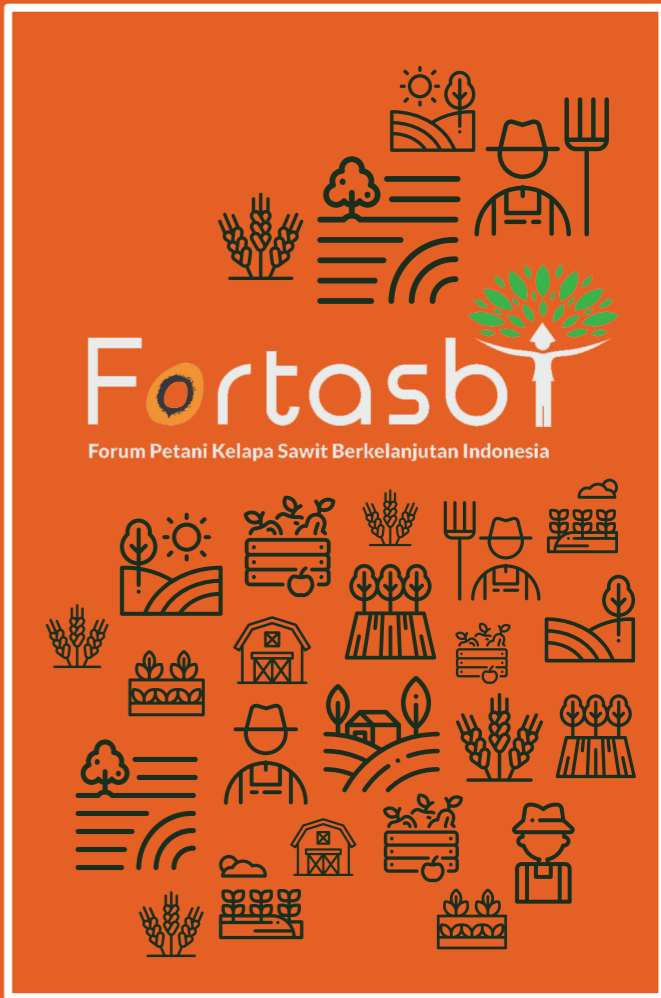

Indonesia Sustainable Palm Oil Independent Smallholders Forum

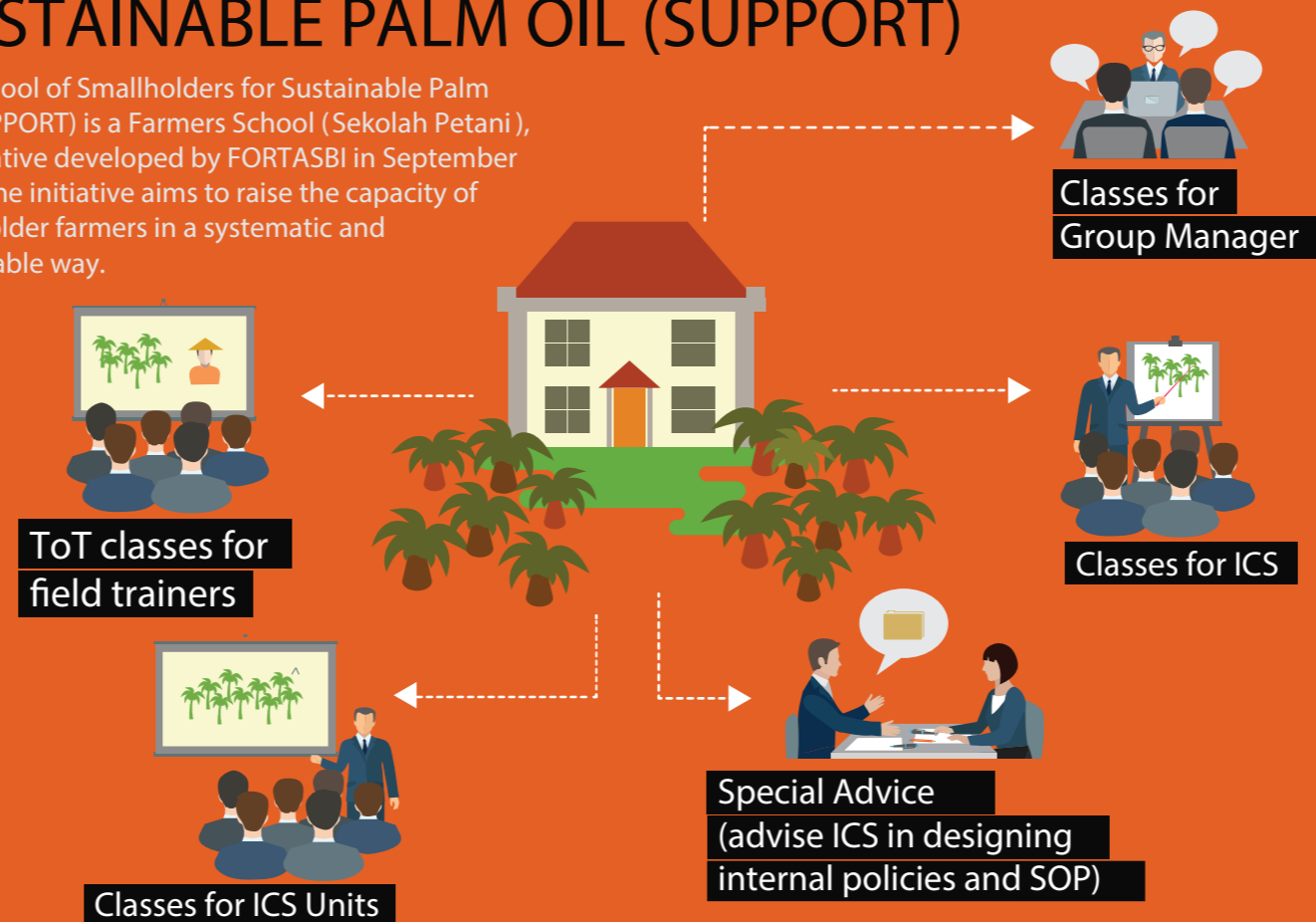
FORTASBI is a forum that was initiated by some NGOs and Independent smallholders in Indonesia on August 14, 2014 in Jambi.

The forum aims to be a place for Indonesian independent smallholders and NGOs to jointly promote sustainable palm oil, either with the RSPO scheme, ISPO scheme, or the ISCC scheme.

FORTASBI is also expected to be a forum for the enhancement of independent smallholders' capacity regardless of their certification status.
