KSU Pantun Sejahtera is committed to implementing sustainable palm oil plantations by implementing RSPO certification standards. This commitment has been proven by the issuance of the RSPO certificate in June 2022 and until now the cooperative is still trying to maintain this commitment.

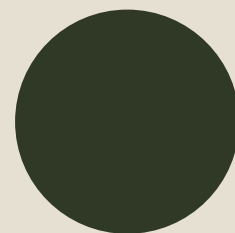

RSPO premium sharing that has been realized

1. Smallholder welfare, namely by providing fertilizer subsidies and weed treatment by a female spraying team. The amount of subsidy provided from the first RSPO premium for farmers is 35% of the total premium. This makes farmers happy because it can reduce farmers' concerns about fertilizer prices which are so high during the premium distribution period.
2. Worker welfare, namely by providing PPE equipment to all RSPO certified member harvesters. The total PPE prepared is adjusted to the number of harvesters, namely 35 harvesters.
3. Social by providing compensation in the form of basic necessities to the elderly and orphans, preferably in cooperative areas. The compensation was provided in collaboration with the village head of Sri Pantun and he said "we are happy because with RSPO certification, local communities who do not have oil palm plantations can also experience the RSPO premium. "Hopefully this program will continue to be sustainable and we as village officials will always support programs that have good aims and are ready to help if needed."
4. Provide training related to the implementation of sustainable plantations to farmers and workers. As well as installing warning bunches as a reminder to administrators, farmers and certification workers to always implement sustainable plantations
5. Maintenance of several infrastructure (roads) in the certification plantation area.
6. Protect river watersheds that are included in the certified land area by placing WARNINGS and marking the management boundaries of watershed plantations.
7. Installation and maintenance of Gupon. This is done to control environmentally friendly rat attacks by utilizing natural enemies, namely owls.





Team Spraying who employ female



From RSPO 2024 Credit funds to implement Best Agricultural Practices (GAP) and stop the use of Paraquad and Group 1A and 1 B herbicides then a spraying team was formed

Team Spraying workers are native women from local residents, There are eight (8) female workers who spray at the Pantun Sejahtera certified smallholder location

Team Spraying workers are paid according to the 2025 East Kutai UMR of IDR. 3,743,820,- or 21,641/Working Hour

Certification smallholders benefit from having their gardens well maintained, making it easier to carry out garden activities such as harvesting, harvesting, shredding palm fruit, etc.





Maintain High Conservation Value



Pantun Sejahtera Cooperative is committed to protecting High Conservation Value (HCV). From 2023 until now, the Pantun Sejahtera Cooperative HCV Team has planted 100 trees in degraded (riparian) areas with the aim of restoring ecosystem conditions.



Installation of warning signs, marking of boundaries for managing gardens manually (without the use of chemicals) and planting erosion prevention plants on the Pantun River border, with a budget of 2% of the total credit obtained

Maintain High Conservation Value

Planting erosion-preventing plants



This planting initiative stands as a testament to Koperasi Pantun Sejahtera's commitment to supporting High Conservation Values (HCV) within their operational environment. By selecting bamboo, known for its strong gripping roots, they hope the riverbank will transform into a natural fortress that protects the aquatic ecosystem and surrounding biodiversity. For the cooperative, prosperity is no longer defined solely by economic profit, but also by the success of passing down a sustainable and safe river environment to future generations.



Training related to the implementation of sustainable palm oil



The training is carried out in Field Schools located in smallholding certified oil palms. Field school is a forum for independent smallholders to gain knowledge and understanding in terms of management and practice Good Agricultural Practices (GAP)

There are three field school locations attended by smallholders and workers
Field schools are held once a month





Infrastructure maintenance (roads) in certified palm oil areas



This activity was carried out with the aim of making it easier for smallholders to get to the plantation and connecting local villages. Road paving is carried out so that during the rainy season people are not disturbed in their work. So that the smallholder economy can continue to run well.

The road being hardened is +- 7 km in the Pantun Sejahtera Cooperative certified plantation area, with a budget of IDR 50,000,000.





Worker welfare



Pantun Sejahtera Cooperative is committed to maintaining a safe workplace. Worker welfare, namely by providing PPE equipment to all harvesters who are members of RSPO certification and BPJS employment insurance. The total PPE prepared is adjusted to the number of harvesters, namely 35 harvesters.
