*First RSPO Credit Received,
Gapoktan Tani Mandiri Aims to
Strengthen Human Resources of
Palm Oil Smallholders*



The Smallholders Group Association (**Gapoktan**) **Tani Mandiri**, which has implemented sustainable palm oil standards, continues to reaffirm its commitment to adopting good agricultural practices.

This smallholder group, consisting of **379 smallholders** cultivating a total of **423.75 hectares** located in the villages of Laut Tador, Tanjung Prapat, and Kandangan in Batu Bara Regency, has established a standard for allocating funds from the sale of RSPO certificates.

The group hopes that with this **certification**, **smallholders** will be able to implement palm oil cultivation practices in line with recommended guidelines, thereby increasing the yield and quality of fresh fruit bunches (FFB).

Moreover, the RSPO credits **will help smallholders establish partnerships with nearby palm oil mills**, further supporting the sustainable palm oil initiative.
